# Important!

## Mandated Immunization Requirement For School Attendance

January 5, 2016

Dear Parents,

- **SB277 has gone into effect as of January 1, 2016. This law no longer permits immunization exemptions based on personal beliefs for children in child care and public and private schools.**

**Where can my child get vaccines?**

- ❖ Your own medical provider
- ❖ San Joaquin County Public Health Department, 1601 Hazelton Ave. Stockton, Phone 468-3830

**What else do I need to do?**

- **Provide documentation to your school's office when registering your child.**
- **Children who do not provide proof of vaccine will not be placed on a class list for the 2016-2017 school year in accordance with State law.**

**What if my child is unable to take this vaccine for medical reasons?**

SB277 allows for Medical waivers obtained from your medical doctor. The waiver must include condition prohibiting immunization, which vaccine is being exempted, whether the medical exemption is permanent or temporary and the expiration date if exemption is temporary.

**When is this information due to the school?**

**By April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2016** – When registering student
