DUAL ENROLLMENT Steps to Apply

STEP
1

Apply for Admission

Complete the online application for admission. Create an Open CCCApply Account, then complete and submit the entire CCCApply Application.

Once submitted, your application will take 2 business days to process, after which time you should receive a Welcome Email from the college.

Complete the Board of Governors Fee Waiver Form

3

Retrieve Your Delta Student ID Number and Email Address

After allowing 2 business days for processing, retrieve your Student ID Number and email information:

- Log in using your social security number (first time only) and date of birth

Schedule and Take the Assessment Test

As a New Student, you are required to take the Assessment Placement to determine your reading, writing, and math levels. Your placement levels ensure that you will start courses that match your college readiness.
